

Michigan Chamber's Radio Spot Urges Voters To Look Beyond Labels in 7th Congressional District

The Michigan Chamber of Commerce is running ads on 26 radio stations across southern Michigan addressing out-of-state groups that have been attacking Congressman Joe Schwarz.

"Those out-of-state groups have tried to dominate the debate -- not on issues, but on labels," explained Michigan Chamber President & CEO Jim Barrett.

"Their bias is getting in the way of the facts. Don't take seriously their claim that Joe Schwarz is some sort of flaming liberal," Barrett added.
